Emergency Wing

- Sankalp received 3 emergency requests per day:
 - Mostly Bombay blood group, apheresis and other negative requests
 - 50.7% requests from outside Bangalore
 - Requests received from Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Pondicherry, New Delhi, Rajasthan and Odisha

Bombay Blood Group

- We received requests for 118 units of Bombay Blood Group for 56 patients – all of them – addressed
- Bombaybloodgroup.org was launched
- 2 exclusive meetings of Bombay Blood Group Donors
- Temperature controlled logistics for up to 72 hours
- First ever international transfer of blood.



DISHA

- Total participation of blood banks increased to 64
 7 new added last year.
- Average of 35 blood requests per day
- Web Application framework to manage blood stock information launched
- Quality control procedures employed to increase effectiveness.

Rakta Kranti - Bangalore

- 78 blood donation drives where
 10,246 donors came forward and
 8,402 units donated
- Bloodmobile
- Effective tracking of post donation discomfort
- Reduced vasovagal reactions by corrective measures
- Better publicity tools
- During the first quarter of peak shortage: 2526 units



Rakta Kranti - Karnataka

- 2 workshops organised "Role of Colleges in Taking Karnataka towards 100% Voluntary Blood Donation" - Rani Channamma University, Belgaum, Gulbarga University
- Persistent effort is being made to sensitise the blood banks
- 14 TeamRed trainings and 2 emergency donor registration drives organised
- Total of 751 willing donors and 617 units of blood collected in 9 blood donation camps covering 8 blood banks
- Companies outside Bangalore started organising blood donation drives



Rakta Kranti Schools

 Awareness programs were organised in 9 schools with a total of 1947 students participating



IBBB/Thalassemia

- Not one of the patients had to organise for a single unit of blood
- 88 new children registered. Now total of 200 children
- Transport support offered for 14 extremely poor patients and critical medicines organised
- Free HLA typing was offered to 15 families.
- Antenatal screening was done for 8 families 7 subsidised and 1 completely funded.

More on Thalassemia

- Sophisticated software system leading to better compliance
- Applied Materials has decided to continue to support the Thalassemia day care at IGICH.
- ABC.org regularly
 contributing to day care



DMMG: Prayas

- 1947 sheets of tarpaulin were distributed Jorhat (Majuli) and Tezpur (Sootea in Sonitpur District) in 2 phases
- In spite of little media attention good participation from the public. Approx 4 lakhs spent
